

## PROJECT OVERVIEW



- The Kicking Horse Canyon Project is a top priority for the Government of British Columbia
- Total project length is 26 kilometres
- The project has been divided into four major phases
- Total cost is estimated at \$972 million, shared with the Government of Canada
- \$207 million has been invested to date (BC \$123.5 million; Canada \$83.5 million)
- Significant use of local resources and labour force

- Improvements include:
  - Highway widening to 4 lanes with a design speed of 100 km/h (80 km/h within Town of Golden)
  - Improved alignments, replacement of narrow bridge structures
  - Significant reduction of rock fall and snow avalanche hazards
  - Improved reliability for travel
  - Improved pedestrian and cycling facilities
  - Wildlife protection, revegetation and other environmental measures
