

# RECENT ACTIVITIES - CONSTRUCTION

Throughout 2005, Emil Anderson Construction Inc. has continued construction to widen and straighten the highway east of the new Yoho Bridge. An innovative cantilevered roadway proposed by the contractor just west of the Rafter's Pullout eliminated the need for two bridges in the original design while reducing construction costs. The deck on this structure has been cast and will be ready to carry traffic by mid-2006. This first phase of the Kicking Horse Canyon Project is to be completed by Fall 2006.



- Traffic is kept moving during construction to straighten sharp curves west of Rafter's Pullout
- Formwork is removed after the concrete deck is cast
- Result is gently curving cantilevered roadway skirting over a bend in the Kicking Horse River
- Traffic will begin using the new structure in Spring 2006
