





UPDATE: Kicking Horse Canyon – May 2024 Traffic Schedule

May 1, 2024

The Kicking Horse Canyon Constructors (KHCC) will continue to implement intermittent stoppages (up to 2 minutes) and full closures (up to 2 hours) on the Trans-Canada Highway for the Kicking Horse Canyon Phase 4 construction through May. Additionally, single-lane alternating traffic delays (up to 30 minutes) will also be implemented. Highway 1 will remain reduced to 2 lanes of traffic through the Kicking Horse Canyon for the duration of the planned work. Travelling speeds will remain at the reduced speed of 50km/h. The following table outlines the planned traffic stoppages and closures for May 2024.

What to Expect



Traffic Effects & Accommodation

- All traffic through the Kicking Horse Canyon is reduced to 50 km/h speed limit
- The highway is reduced from 4 travel lanes to 2 travel lanes (one lane in each direction) through the Kicking Horse Canyon for the duration of the remaining work.
- During the full closures (up to 2 hours) there will be emergency responder access from both ends, but no through traffic available to the public.
- Both approaches to Kicking Horse Canyon will be well-signed and traffic control personnel will be onsite to direct traffic as required.
- Drivers are reminded to obey construction-zone speed limits and the direction of traffic control personnel.
- Roadside signage will provide advance notification of the delays.
- Day-to-day information will be available on <u>DriveBC.</u>
